Telemetry RN

The Registered Nurse, as a professional practitioner employed by Midwest Nursing & Vascular services, assumes responsibility and accountability for the application of the nursing process and the delivery of patient care. The nurse demonstrates ability to make clinical judgments in an effective and efficient manner with supervision. The nurse demonstrates critical thinking and performance ability in the coordination of patient care. Consistently performs according to nursing standards and is accountable in managing patient care and assisting others in the management of patient care. The nurse always demonstrates exceptional communication skills in a friendly and courteous manner.

- 1. Provides nursing care to adult and geriatric patients with routine diagnoses of Heart Failure, Renal Failure, Pneumonia, Chest Pain, Acute Coronary Syndrome, Dysrhythmias, etc.
- 2. Equipment that may be utilized in the unit/department include telemetry monitoring, computerized charting, 12-lead EKG, patient transfer equipment, IV pumps, electronic medication dispensing machines, etc.
- 3. A minimum of two years of cardiology nursing experience required.
- 4. State nursing license, BLS, and ACLS certifications required.
- 5. Shift generally 12 hour day or night as needed.
- 6. Dress Code: Navy Blue scrubs, or per facility requirements.
- 7. Unit/department required specific training and orientation.

Minimum Requirements:

- Current Registered Nurse License for the State
- Proof current MMR & Varicella Titers, TB, and Flu immunizations
- Two years prior professional nursing experience in telemetry or similar area
- Current BLS, ACLS
- Approved Professional Background screening
- Negative 10-Panel Drug Screen
