

ICU RN

RN performs total patient care.

Equipment that may be utilized in the unit/department:

Computerized documentation, Omnicell or other medication dispensing machines, Nihon Kohden or other monitoring devices, Plum, Omni, etc. IV pumps, Stryker beds, and ventilators.

Required minimum years of experience:

Minimum of **2 years** ICU experience required.

Specific licensure and certifications required:

State RN license, BLS, ACLS. Prefer CCRN and PCRN

Shift or schedule requirements:

Shifts are 12 hours and/or as posted, and generally every other weekend.

Floating to other units/departments:

ICU nurses may be required to float to similar departments.

Nurse to patient ratio generally:

ICU-1:2, IMCU 1:3

Dress code: Navy blue scrubs or department required, tattoos must be covered, body piercings limited to one per ear.

Unit/department specific training and orientation program:

RN will attend scheduled hospital orientation and/or complete online training.

Minimum Requirements:

- Current Registered Nurse License for the state in which the nurse practices.
- Proof current MMR & Varicella Titers, TB, and FLU immunizations.
- Two years prior professional nursing experience in required field.
- Current BLS and ACLS.
- Successful completion of screening tests for the clinical specialty area(s) in which the RN practices with a score of 80% or greater
- Approved Professional Background screening.
- Negative 10-Panel Drug Screen
