Vascular Access Specialist Job Description

The Vascular Access Specialist:

Follows the national Standards of Practice set by the Infusion Nurses Society.

Follows all MNVS policies and procedures.

Arrives within two hours at requesting facility.

Inserts PICC/Midlines per physician order at the patient's bedside or designated area.

Troubleshoots/declots obstructed central line catheters.

Monitors PICC/Midline and educates staff on prevention of line infection and routine care.

Submits surveillance data for Quality and Infection Control.

Provides infusion consultation services to enhance the intravenous skills of the nursing staff through bedside teaching, central line troubleshooting, and consultation on any infusion therapy questions.

Teaches patients and staff how to care for the line.

Completes all paperwork as required by hospital and MNVS.

Required Experience:

- Two years experience in PICC/Midline Insertions

Minimum Requirements:

- Current Registered Nursing License for the State
- Current MMR & Varicella Titers Titer, TB, and Flu immunizations
- Two years prior professional nursing experience in required field
- Current BLS, ACLS.
- Approved Professional Background screening.
- Negative 10-Panel Drug Screen
